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- No schools/amenities and no easy access with single track roads.
- Properties currently unsold in the village.
- No main sewage.
- Sites flood.
- Social housing not successful, no Topcroft locals.
- Over development in historical part of village.
- Sites are enclosed common land, which keeps Topcroft as a rural village and 'pretty' part.
- A 40% increase in houses in The Street.
- Ecological value in wet common land.
- Topcroft identified as an 'Other Village' in Policy 16/Joint Core Strategy. A defined development boundary within which very limited infill development can occur without affecting the form/character of village.
