The Chair thanked District Councillor Michael Edney for his grant for this project. Cllrs discussed the completed work at the bus shelter and commented there was not a dropped kerb for elderly and wheelchair users. NCC's Disability Discrimination Act (DDA) compliant specification stated:

TPC's bus stop does not meet the current standards for a DDA compliant bus stop. The new hardstanding area would include full height kerbing where users have to access the bus, but would also include dropped kerbs to enable those who are elderly/less able to use the bus stop.
